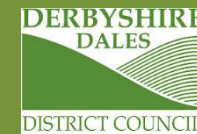

'Overarching *lead* role for the coordination of Risk Management Authorities (RMAs) and management of local flood risk across the county of Derbyshire.'

- Historical flood information.
- Surface water flood mapping.

- Updating the Asset Register
- Flood enquiries (many in conjunction with District Authorities)

Sandbags and FloodSax
